

Coeymans Survey Analysis

As part of the public outreach process for the Town of Coeymans, an Online Resident Survey was developed. Coeymans residents were invited to complete the survey via the internet or they could request a paper copy of the survey. A total of 334 households completed one version of the survey, representing 865 residents (average household size of 2.59 persons) and a survey response rate of 11.5%.




Q2. Survey respondents were asked to indicate the age range of everyone in their household.


Q3. In the survey, residents were asked to indicate how long they have lived in the Town of Coeymans.



Q4. Survey respondents were asked to indicate how many acres of land they own in Coeymans.




Q5. Breakdown of survey respondents by Income Range.




Q6. In the survey, residents were asked to identify how they would categorize their home.



Q7. Survey respondents were asked to identify where in the Town of Coeymans they live or own property.




Q8. Survey respondents were asked to indicate three reasons why they enjoy living in Coeymans.





Q9. Survey respondents were asked to indicate their satisfaction level with facilities, services, and conditions in Coeymans.


Q10. In the survey, residents were asked to identify the top three improvements they would like to see occur in the Town.




Q11. In the survey, residents were asked to indicate their opinions on a variety of local community and development issues.


Q12. Survey respondents were asked to identify what type of development the Town should encourage. Respondents were invited to identify all they felt applicable.




Q13. In the survey, respondents were asked to identify their top three preferred locations for additional commercial development in the Town.





Q14. Survey respondents were asked to identify what they felt were the least positive aspects about living in the Town of Coeymans. They were invited to identify three.




Q15. In the survey, residents were asked whether or not they would like to see more public use areas near the Hudson River.
