- Secure grant funding through The Hudson River Valley Greenway to fund the development of the NRI
- 2. Hold community NRI meeting in February
- 3. If possible, use community NRI meeting as a stepping stone to develop a community conservation round table
- 4. Assist with TB movement toward CEC & CSC
- 5. Partner with Town Library to develop bi-monthly CAC sponsor program at the library
- 6. Partner with Ravena-Coeymans-Selkirk Central School District (RCS) to engage students in conservation efforts

7. Develop CAC social media presence to help get the word out for CAC events and activities
