Council member Schmitt broke down the contract as signed and asked if the Village would be contributing to the cost as well. Supervisor Donnelly said that was not discussed. Supervisor Donnelly brought the idea to the Village as an act of good faith. Council member Bruno stated you cannot offer services that have an expense like that without proper discussion. Council member Stott suggested to table it. Council member Schmitt said he is not opposed to the idea and feels there should be a discussion about this decision. Council member Hotaling clarified that the program already encompasses the Village and no additional cost will not be incurred to add an additional administrator. Council member Hotaling suggested finishing out this contract and revisiting the cost when it is time to renew. Council member Stott agrees with Council members Hotaling's suggestion as did everyone else.

Public Comment: Barbara Tanner asked for clarification on the grant writer. Supervisor Donnelly said she is still the Grant writer but her compensation hasn't been decided upon. She asked why Supervisor Donnelly voted no on the social worker. He said he was not opposed to it but wanted to research where the funds were coming from. Ms. Tanner asked for clarification if an additional user on CodeRED would increase the cost, it was clarified there is no additional cost to add an administrator. Mrs. Tanner reminded the board it is necessary to speak up for the audience.

<u>Zachary Assael</u> resides on Fox street. He asked the board for a moratorium on building in the industrial area near the Port of Coeymans.

<u>Debbie Oatman</u> asked what the legalities were to remove the appeal associated with Long Energy. She feels as it is a frivolous matter. Supervisor Donnelly asked Town Attorney Reilly if he cared to comment. Mr. Reilly stated they are still learning all the details regarding the appeal. He also stated his firm is not the attorney of record for this case.
